CODE OF CONDUCT

For Parents/Guardians

Encourage your child to learn the rules and participate within them.

- Discourage challenging/ arguing with officials.
- Treat all club officials and coaches with respect, and show appreciation for the support that these people give to your child over and above the call of duty – particularly at events & competitions.
- Publicly accept official's judgements.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Set a good example by recognising good sportsmanship and applauding the good performance of all.
- Encourage your child to fully support their other team mates at competitions and other events.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Always ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the activity and has plenty to drink.
- Keep the club informed if your child is ill or unable to attend sessions.
- Endeavour to establish good communications with the club, coaches and officials for the benefit of all.
- Share any concerns or complaints about any aspect of the club through the approved channels.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Never punish or belittle a child for poor performance or making mistakes.
- Always collect your child promptly at the end of a session. Children will not be released unless either parent is present, or a letter of release had been received by the parent or guardian, thereby removing responsibility from the club. Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
